

The Voivodship Teachers' Advisory Centre in Zgierz started its activities on July 1, 2014. It is a new regional institution which provides special didactic support for teachers from 157 educational institutions in the Kutno district, 90 such institutions in the Łęczyca district and 251 in the Zgierz district. The Centre is in the historical building which housed the Zgierz Teacher Training College which was dissolved in 2016 as part of national education policy and had professionally trained future teachers during the many years of its activity. The current professional level of the advisory staff has also been maintained at the level of the European standards.

The mission of the Teachers' Advisory Centre in Zgierz is to meet the challenges and expectations of the contemporary educational labour market and to guarantee the continuity and coherence of educational activities and the high quality of offered services. The Centre offers training aimed at improving the professional skills of head teachers and teachers of educational institutions and also supporting their personal development. During the training sessions, the knowledge and skills of all participants are used, which creates an atmosphere conducive to cooperation, the exchange of experiences and implementation of joint educational projects. The goal of the centre is to raise the professional skills of directors and teachers in the special areas of creative development and taking initiative. Its work supports a systematic improvement of the quality of education in Polish schools and educational institutions in accordance with national educational policy.

WODN in Zgierz employs sixteen qualified, competent, committed and responsible pedagogical staff; teacher-consultants and non-teaching specialists. All these employees strive for good interpersonal relationships and effective interpersonal communication. They systematically improve their professional competence by participating, among others, in study visits. WODN in Zgierz cooperates with 3 local teacher-advisors in the fields of Polish language education, general science and early years education.

The Centre actively promotes its achievements and has already developed a good reputation in the local environment in the short time of its existence. The use of active working methods and innovative solutions, as well as conducting classes, open lessons and scientific seminars, guarantees a high quality of work. The Centre also offers the possibility of meeting Polish and foreign experts. The offers are updated on an ongoing basis, in accordance with educational needs. The offer of free training for teachers during holidays is worth mentioning.

A rich and extremely aesthetic teaching base includes computer rooms, a music and dance room, a sports hall, an assembly hall and a library. It also has a technical laboratory and a premedical aid workshop, the only ones in the region, which ensure a high level of training. The location of the Centre, with the total area of 1.6 ha including 3,600 sq m of the building, is customer friendly. The proximity of the main railway station, tram and bus stops and a car park, which is monitored 24 hours a day, make it easy to arrive to meetings in time.
